Governance Review 2018/19

Stroud District Council is undertaking a **Community Governance Review (CGR)** of parish and town councils to make sure that, at parish level, governance arrangements are working as effectively and efficiently as they should be for the public.

**PHASE 1: The initial consultation runs from
3rd September to 26th November 2018**

A Community Governance Review is the process used to consider whether existing parish arrangements should be changed in any way. This includes:

- Altering the boundaries of existing parishes;
- Changing the names of existing parishes;
- Creating a new parish or abolishing an existing parish;
- The electoral arrangements for parish councils (including the number of Councillors and arrangements for parish warding);
- The grouping or de-grouping of parish councils (and consequential changes to their electoral arrangements).
